Position Summary: This position works under minimal supervision from the Executive Director and Director of Operations. We are seeking a passionate gardener and goal-oriented self-starter willing to take ownership of Nursery operations, output and appearance. He/she will work mostly outdoors growing plants for the park and for sale to the public. Position involves working approximately 33-40 hours per week.

Minimum Qualifications: Requires a high school diploma or equivalent, college coursework and/or acquired knowledge of Botany, and a minimum of 2 – 5 years of related work experience. Prefer specialization in native plants. Prefer some ability to communicate in Spanish.

Working Conditions: Work is performed mainly outdoors subject to the weather and during daylight hours. Office workspace is climate controlled.

Physical Demands: Requires the ability to stand up to 70% of the time; walk up to 20% of the time; and sit up to 10% of the time. Requires the ability to lift and carry up to 40 pounds and push a wheelbarrow. Also requires the ability to stoop, kneel, crouch, reach, handle, speak, hear and see in color vision.
